- Exhibit good sportsmanship at all times, never condone violations of the rules of the game or exhibit behaviour contrary to the spirit of the rules of the game.
- Remember that children should be playing Netball primarily for their own enjoyment. Do not put pressure on the children.
- Place the well-being and safety of each player above all other considerations.
- Encourage your child, and others, or be quiet. Praise effort and performance, not results.
- Parents must encourage and guide players to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance.
- No offensive, abusive or insulting remarks shall be made toward any player, official, or parent.
- Respect the umpires decisions at all times and avoid words or actions which may mislead or upset a Match umpire.
- Make sure you stay OUTSIDE of the court at all the time. If you bring your dog to the venue, please make sure you don't bring them onto the court.
- Please make sure that any litter goes in the bins outside the courts.
